



Then, layer the ingredients in the jar, starting with those that will be used last. If the final step of the recipe calls for the addition of flour and baking soda, for example, then that combination should be your bottom layer in the jar, while the sugars, which are blended with the butter in the first step of the recipe, should be your top layer in the jar.

As you create each layer, tap the jar to level out the ingredients. When you have finished layering the dry ingredients, top the jar with a lid. Cut a circle of fabric to fit over the lid and secure it with a ribbon. Finally, type or write out the directions for making the cookies on the recipe card and attach it to the jar.

You may use as many cookie recipes as you would like. Just be sure to look for ones with a limited number of liquid ingredients, like milk, water and eggs. You don't want the receiver to have to spend a small fortune buying the additional ingredients needed to complete the recipe.

Make one or several cookie mixes in a jar for friends and family far away, pack them carefully and send them with your love a few weeks before Christmas. You're sure to make many people happy with your special treat.
