

Town Hall. Built in 1886, the building served as one-room schoolhouse. It was then used as the library from 1898 until 1971, when it became home to the Jamestown Historical Society. The museum's interior was refurbished in 2008 when heat and air conditioning were installed. The museum holds a new exhibit each year. Admission is free from late June until September, Wednesday through Sunday, 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. and by appointment.

Fire Museum

Also downtown is the Jamestown Fire Department Memorial Museum, right next to the fire station. The museum was opened in 1959. An addition was later built to house the antique Lafrance Steam Fire Engine.

Beside the 100-year-old fire engine, the two-story structure houses antique firefighting equipment, complete with the old-fashioned poles firefighters used to slide down to get to their engines.

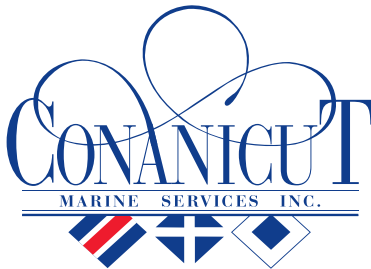
The museum is open on weekdays, with free of admission, from 7 a.m. until 3 p.m. ▲
