

## Carlisle scholarships available to islanders

The Jamestown Lions have announced plans to make the 11th annual award of the Carlisle scholarships. The scholarships were established in memory of Rebecca Carlisle and her daughter Leigha, who were killed in an automobile collision in January, 1995.

The Rebecca Carlisle Memorial Scholarship is awarded each year to a college-bound resident of Jamestown who is a mother with children in her care. Applicants are required to demonstrate financial need and a record of scholastic achievement. Mothers enrolled at or admitted to a four-year college program, with an actual or intended registration in an area of study involving environmental issues, are given preference.

The Leigha Carlisle Memorial Scholarship is awarded each year to a college-bound Jamestown resident who demonstrates financial need, a record of scholastic and sports or dance achievement. The recipient must be a graduating high school senior admitted to a four-year college.

The scholarships are awarded by a committee consisting of a representative of the Jamestown Teachers Association, the Jamestown Parent-Teacher Organization, and the Jamestown School Committee. Letters of application may be submitted to the Jamestown Lions, c/o John A. Murphy, Treasurer, 77 Narragansett Ave., Jamestown, RI 02835-1149. Documentation of the requirements described above must be submitted with each letter of application. Deadline for applications is May 1.

The two scholarship funds were initiated with donations from members of the family of Rebecca and Leigha Carlisle. Anyone wishing to make a donation to the funds may do so by sending it to the Jamestown Lions at the above address.

## NKHS earns recognition for counseling

The American School Counselors Association has announced that North Kingstown High School has been designated as a Recognized ASCA Model Program school and will be recognized during a special ceremony at ASCA's annual conference in Chicago, Ill., on June 26.

Awarded to schools that align with the criteria set in the "ASCA National Model: A Framework for School Counseling," the RAMP designation recognizes schools that are committed to delivering a comprehensive, data-driven school counseling program and an exemplary educational environment. North Kingstown High School is to be commended for its dedication to serving all students with a comprehensive, data-driven school counseling program that shows how students are different as a result of what school counselors do.

North Kingstown High School's school counseling program was reviewed three times by a panel of school counseling professionals in order to receive this award. The school is one of 21 to achieve RAMP status since the program's inception. They are the first school in New England to receive the award and only the seventh high school nationwide to be honored.

## JAMESTOWN BRIDGE 1940 - 2006



The demolition of the old Jamestown Bridge is underway. A controlled explosion, resulting in demolition of the through truss (superstructure at the center of the bridge), is scheduled to take place on Tuesday, April 11, 2006.

The new Jamestown-Verrazzano Bridge (Route 138) will be closed to traffic that day between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes and avoid the area if at all possible during the closure time.


The demolition will be broadcast live at Cox Digital Cable Channel 124 and will be webcast at [www.dot.state.ri.us](http://www.dot.state.ri.us).

There are no nearby viewing areas, but the University of Rhode Island's Narragansett Bay Campus, South Ferry Road, Narragansett, has a clear line of sight to the bridge.

The demolition is subject to change by adverse weather or safety concerns.
