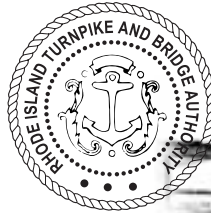

May 11, 1987 - Early morning thunderstorms produced up to four inches of rain in southern Texas, with flooding reported from Maverick County to Eagle Pass. Evening thunderstorms in northern Illinois produced hail the size of golf balls and wind gusts to 70 mph.

May 12, 1971 - Dust storms suddenly reduced visibilities to near zero on Interstate Highway 10 near Casa Grande, Ariz. Chain reaction accidents involving cars and trucks resulted, killing seven people.

There is also a 7-year-old, living with his mother who needs a male role model and three boys, 6, 10, and 11, who are in Child & Family Services group home. All like age-typical activities and do not have family able to visit them.

CFS staff feels that all of these youths would thrive with attention from volunteers who could focus on them and share in fun activities. Both an interview and fingerprinting are required. An introduction to the child will be arranged before any match is finalized. Staff is always available to provide direction and answer questions.
