**Newport District Court dispositions**

- Kathleen Champagne, 18, of 5 Pleasant View Drive pleaded no contest July 14 to a charge of possession of alcoholic beverages by an underage person. She was fined \$150, ordered to perform 10 hours of community service and pay court costs, police said.

- Benjamin Coulter, 21, of Newport pleaded no contest July 14 to a charge of driving with a suspended license. He was fined \$250 and court costs, which were stayed pending re-instatement of his license, police said.


