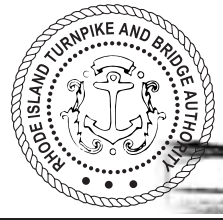

Aug. 10, 1980 - Hurricane Allen came ashore above Brownsville, Texas, dropping 15 inches of rain near San Antonio and up to 20 inches in the lower Rio Grande Valley. Tidal flooding occurred along the south Texas coast. Hurricane Allen packed winds to 150 mph.

Aug. 11, 1944 - The temperature at Burlington, Vt. soared to an all-time record high of 101 degrees. The "Dog Days" officially come to an end on this date, having begun the third day in July. Superstition has it that dogs tend to become mad during this time of the year.
