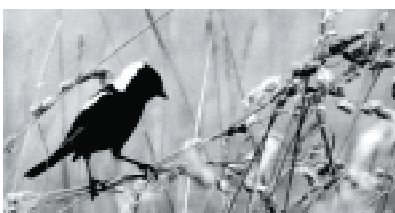
A New Farm Product

Several Jamestown farmers have agreed to cooperate with the Nature Services Exchange (NSE) to create a new farm product - bird nesting services in hayfields - that they can integrate into their traditional self-determined mix of products to sell to the community.

Under the agreements, the farmers will be compensated to delay hay harvest and avoid cattle grazing to enable bobolinks and other wildlife to survive the primary nesting and breeding season (May 7 to July 6).

Now the NSE needs to bring together a group of residents to support each of these contracts. In the next few weeks, we will open a Jamestown exchange so that you will have the opportunity to purchase a share of a farm/wildlife contract.
