**Aug. 2, 1989** - Low pressure representing the remains of Hurricane Chantal deluged north central Texas with heavy rain. Up to 6.50 inches drenched Stephens County, and Wichita Falls reported 2.22 inches of rain in just one hour.

**Aug. 3, 1970** - Hurricane Celia struck the coast of Texas producing wind gusts to 161 mph at Corpus Christi. The hurricane was the most destructive of record along the Texas coast causing 454 million dollars in damage and claiming 11 lives.

## Tour library's special collection

Join the Friends of the Jamestown Library and celebrate the history of Jamestown on Friday, Aug. 17, between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m., in the Sydney L. Wright Museum as Jane Bentley presents a lively and informative tour of the museum.

Bentley taught at the Jamestown school for 28 years and every year, whatever grade she taught, she always included the history of Jamestown. She served as an officer on the Jamestown Historical Society for twenty years and was in charge of house tours. In her capacity on that board, she also gave several tours of Narragansett Avenue and will be doing that this summer for the historical society for the 350th anniversary celebration.

When she first started teaching, Catherine Morris Wright came into her third grade class to talk about the archaeological dig that took place at the site of the Lawn Avenue School. Jane's enthusiasm began that day and continues to the present. She will speak about those artifacts that were excavated in the 70's and displayed in the museum. She will also give a brief overview of the excavation and how it came about and answer questions at the end of the talk. Jane has lived in Jamestown all of her life and loves to share the knowledge she has acquired over the years.
