to permanently protect the Ceppi, Dutra, and Neale farms.

The anticipated cost of this protection is over \$11,000,000 and will be borne by multiple parties, including the Town of Jamestown and Champlin Foundation. The Federal government and State of

Rhode Island have allocated \$4,000,000 toward the purchase of development rights to these farms. The Federal contribution will be withdrawn if the purchase does not take place by September 30, 2007. To meet the deadline and take advantage of the Federal and State money, the Land Trust needs to raise \$4,000,000.

Thus, it is fair to say we have work ahead of us. It would not be wrong to call it a crisis.

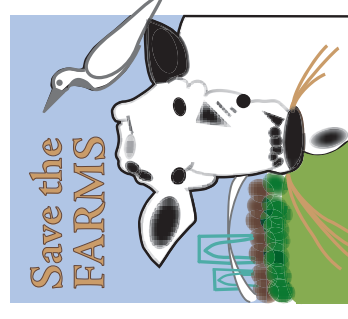
