Weather History

Nov. 8, 1989 - Afternoon and evening thunderstorms developing along and ahead of a cold front produced severe weather from northern Louisiana into central Georgia. Thunderstorms spawned three tornadoes and there were 64 reports of large hail or damaging winds.

Nov. 9, 1913 - The "freshwater fury," a rapidly deepening cyclone, caused unpredicted gales on the Great Lakes. Eight ore carriers on Lake Erie sank, drowning 270 sailors.
