Holiday concert coming soon

The Jamestown Community Chorus will present its 2007 Holiday Concerts on Saturday, Dec. 8, at 7:30 p.m., and Sunday, Dec. 9, at 3 p.m., at the Central Baptist Church, 99 Narragansett Ave., in Jamestown.

LEGAL TIP

RV tire failure is causing major litigation because of major injuries. Classically, it is one of the front tires in the RV that blows out (often at highway speeds) that makes it impossible to steer or control the huge and heavy RV.

Investigation is showing problems with the design of the large RVs where heavy loads coupled with weight shifting inside the RV puts too much pressure on the tires. In addition, there are problems with the tire design as although some tires as good for certain trucks they are not adequate for RVs. Thirdly, tires may appear new with good tread, but because RVs are seasonal the tires may dry rot causing a blowout. Any of these three reasons can cause sudden tire failure on an RV resulting in injury to occupants of the RV or in other vehicles that are struck.

This can cause liability on the RV manufacturer, the tire manufacturer and the owner of the RV.
