### LEGAL TIP

A tenant who slipped down stairs in his apartment could not seek tort damages for the landlord's alleged breach of duties imposed by the state landlord and tenant act, the Virginia Supreme Court has ruled.

The plaintiff filed suit after falling on worn and slippery stairs located inside his apartment. He claimed that his injuries resulted from the landlord's failure to keep the stairs in good repair in violation of the state landlord and tenant act, and that the act provided tenants such as himself a private cause of action in tort.

A judge awarded summary judgement for the landlord. The Virginia Supreme Court affirmed.

In Rhode Island there would be a different result under our landlord and tenant act as the landlord is obligated to keep the premises in good repair.
