**Weather History**

**Jan. 24, 1916** - The temperature at Browning, Mont. plunged 100 degrees in just 24 hours, from 44 degrees above zero to 56 degrees below zero. It was a record 24-hour temperature drop for the United States.

**Jan. 25, 1837** - At 7 p.m., a display of the northern lights danced above Burlington, Vt. Its light was equal to the full moon. Snow and other objects reflecting the light were deeply tinged with a blood red hue. Blue, yellow and white streamers were also noted.

### Melrose preschool taking applications

The Melrose Avenue Preschool is now accepting applications for the 2008 - 2009 school year. The program is designed to be a fully inclusive program, supporting all children, ages 3 to 5.
