Municipal Water and Sewer Customers

The Municipal sanitary sewer system experienced an overflow this past week. The cause of this overflow was the infiltration or inflow of surface or ground water into the sanitary sewer system. Inflow is a discharge of extraneous water from roof leaders, cellar drains, foundation drains or sump pumps. The inflow of this extraneous water into the sewer system is detrimental to Narragansett Bay, adds additional operational costs to the annual budget as well as reducing the available capacity of sewer lines, pumping stations and the treatment plant. These types of connections and uses of the sewer system are not legal in accordance with State regulations and the Town of Jamestown Sewer Use Ordinance.

Your cooperation in removing these sources of inflow from the sanitary sewer system is required. Please inspect your property for the presence of any of these inflow conditions and make the necessary arrangements to remove them from the sanitary system.
