Chafee to speak at annual meeting

Former U.S. Senator Lincoln Chafee will address the Friends of the Jamestown Library Annual Meeting, which will be held on Wednesday, June 4, at 7 p.m. at the library.

Chafee will be the featured speaker and will discuss his new book "Against the Tide: How a Compliant Congress Empowered a Reckless President." Copies of the book will be available for purchase.

Lincoln Davenport Chafee was born and raised in Rhode Island. He earned a degree in Classics from Brown University in 1975. While there, he was captain of the wrestling team and received the Francis M. Driscoll Award for leadership, scholarship and athletics.

After graduation, Senator Chafee attended horseshoeing school in Bozeman, Montana. For the next seven years, he worked as a blacksmith at harness racetracks in the United States and Canada. One of the horses he shod, Overburden, set the track record at Northlands Park in Edmonton, Alberta.

Upon returning to Rhode Island, Senator Chafee served two terms on the Warwick City Council and was elected Mayor of Warwick four times. As mayor, Chafee had a strong record of fiscal management, environmental protection, open space acquisition, inter-governmental cooperation, economic

development, good labor relations, and significant increases in funding for schools.

In November, 1999, Chafee was appointed to fill the unexpired term of his father, Sen. John H. Chafee, who died while in office. In 2000, Chafee was elected to a six-year term in the United States Senate, where he served on the Committee on Foreign Relations and the Committee on Environment and Public Works.

In 2006, Chafee prevailed in a September primary but lost the November election in a nationally-watched race. He is currently a Distinguished Visiting Fellow at the Watson Institute at Brown University in Providence.

There will be a short business meeting before the program, which is free and open to the general public. Refreshments will be served.

Gospel choir to perform in Newport

For over 25 years the Delco Mass Choir of Delaware County, Pa. has been presenting gospel music concerts and delighting audiences across the country. The Choir will make its annual appearance in Newport on Saturday, June 14 in a program to honor the late Jean E. Hicks, who was the executive director of New Visions for Newport County from 1987 to her death in January 1994.

The concert will be sponsored by East Bay Community Action Program (EBCAP) and Hicks will be honored by the social service

agency she supported for more than 20 years. Hicks was the catalyst behind the development of the New Visions health center, and led the campaign to raise \$1.3 million to secure the agency's permanent home at 19 Broadway, Newport.

The concert will be at 7 p.m. at the Community Baptist Church, 50 Marcus Wheatland Blvd.

There is no admission fee for the concert, but a free will offering will be taken during the concert to support the Jean E. Hicks Memorial Health Center which provides medical and dental services to thousands of Newport County and East Bay residents who may be uninsured or underinsured.
