"Absentee ballot requests must be received by 4 p.m. on Oct. 14," Montoya said. "Parents of college students who want to vote in the election can request a ballot for their student or the student can access the application on the town Website." Applications may be downloaded online, but must be printed and completed before they are signed and mailed in.

"Every election I have someone who has to spend their money to Fed Ex their application in to make sure it is here on time," Montoya said.

Voters who need to change their address may do so when they vote in Tuesday's election or they may stop by Town Hall and fill out a change of address form.

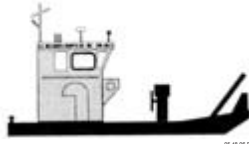
