Nov. 6, 1987 - High winds in the northeastern United States gust-ed to 63 mph at Rhode Island, turning a recent warm spell into a distant memory. Squalls resulting from the high winds produced five inches of snow at Marquette, Mich. and seven inches at Rome, N.Y.

Nov. 7, 1940 - The Galloping Gertie bridge at Tacoma, Wash. collapsed in strong winds just four months after its grand opening, resulting in a six million dollar loss.
