NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE JAMESTOWN ZONING BOARD OF REVIEW WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING JULY 28, 2009, AT THE JAMESTOWN TOWN HALL 93 NARRAGANSETT AVENUE, JAMESTOWN, RHODE ISLAND AT 7:00 P.M. UPON THE FOLLOWING:

Application of the Jamestown Arts Center (Freebody LLC, owner), whose property is located at 18 Valley St., and further identified as Tax Assessor's Plat 8, Lot 461 for variances and special use permits under Article 3,

Section 82-302, District Dimensional Regulations, Table 3-1.IV.1 and 3-2 to grant a special use permit for an educational use and to allow dimensional relief from required lot size, lot coverage, and building setbacks to change the use of an existing nonconforming structure and Section 82-306 to allow a new fixed canopy to project to the front property line (to the line of existing concrete steps); Article 12, Section 82-1202 to allow a parking space to be located within 7 feet of a street where 10 feet is required and to locate parking spaces in the side yard rather than in the rear portion of the property; Section 82-1203.11 to provide 8 on-site parking spaces where 16 are required; Section 82-1205 and Section

82-1205.1 to grant a special use permit for a shared parking arrangement; Article 13, Section 82-1304 to grant a special use permit for building signage. Said property is located in a CL zone and contains 10,000 sq. ft.

Volunteers sought for area events, organizations

Several area organizations are seeking help for upcoming events.

The Wickford Art Association is looking for volunteers to work two-hour shifts at its annual art festival on July 11 and 12. Volunteers will staff the information booth, sell T-shirts and raffle tickets, and assist artists.

The Big Apple Circus in Charlestown is looking for ushers. Duties include showing patrons to their assigned seats, and sweeping and picking up trash in the stands after the show. Applicants must volunteer to be part of a team that will work three or four shows. They also will be required to attend an orientation before the opening. The circus will be held from July 10 to 15.

Parking attendants are being sought by the Big Apple Circus. Applicants must be at least 16 years old and able to stand for two hours. They will be asked to attend a pre-circus orientation meeting.

They will be allowed to attend the show they work if the circus is not sold out.

Drivers are urgently needed in the Jamestown area, Mondays through Fridays, to help elderly neighbors keep their medical appointments.

Senior centers around South County are looking for volunteers for several programs. They include Senior Health Insurance Program volunteers. Training will be provided.

Nutrition program volunteers are needed to help with set-up, serving and clean-up for noontime meals, and activities volunteers are needed to teach classes.

South County Museum in Narragansett needs people to prepare news releases for local press and membership. It is also seeking volunteers to research artifacts to be displayed, to create a museum tour booklet and to greet visitors at the admissions desk. Volunteers will

never have to wear costumes.
