Dylan
(1997-2009)

Dylan was found in an animal shelter in the fall of 1997 in Ithaca, New York by representatives of the State of New York's Arson Bureau. Dylan was recognized for his potential to be trained as an accelerant detection canine.

In 1998 Dylan and his handler MaryJo Thomas, a fire investigator with the Rhode Island State Fire Marshal's Office were partnered together and began their training at the New York State Academy of Fire Science in Montour Falls, New York. In 1999 Dylan was nationally certified by the United States Police Canine Association as an Accelerant Detection Canine.

Dylan worked several major fire investigations across the State of Rhode Island with Investigator Thomas until his retirement in 2000 when Investigator Thomas was hired by the Federal Bureau of Investigation as a Special Agent.

Special Agent Thomas transferred Dylan's care to her sister JoEllen and Arthur of Jamestown, RI. Dylan loved living out his retirement years in Jamestown. He would spend hours chasing his ball at Fort Wetherill Park and swimming at Sheffield Cove.

Dylan's passing on July 6, 2009 has created a void that won't soon be filled.

He was a hard working dog, but most importantly he was a devoted member of our family who will always be remembered, loved and deeply missed by all of us.

In recognition of Dylan's law enforcement contributions, the FBI Laboratory's Forensic Canine Program has added Dylan's name to the list of names to be used for new FBI K9 recruits.
